La Motte Méthode Cap Classique (Brut)

This classic Pinot Noir Chardonnay blend has a typical champagne blush colour, with a very fine, lively mousse. On the nose there are delicious strawberry flavours complemented by yeasty dough and biscuit aromas.

The combination of a good vintage and thirty months' maturation in new wood has produced a wine with exceptional depth, complexity and personality. The first impression is that of floral perfume and potpourri, combined with the flavours of sweet stewed prunes and liquorice, backed by caramel wood flavour. The tannins of the wood and grapes are combined, to form a highly structured, surprisingly soft palate.

The Pierneef Collection

This premium range is a tribute to South African artist Jacob Hendrik Pierneef (1886 – 1957), famous for his mastery in portraying the unadorned beauty of the South African landscape and its architecture. Each new release in the range reflects a different piece of Pierneef art on its label. Limited in supply, the range consists of varietal wines and innovative blends. Grapes are sourced from site-specific vineyards and organically grown vines in specific terroirs.

La Motte Pierneef Sauvignon Blanc (Organically Grown)

The grapes originate from La Motte's organic vineyards on the Nabot farm in the Walker Bay region. It is a fuller wine, un-wooded and a perfect expression of its terroir, which is enhanced by cool breezes from the nearby Indian Ocean.

Imagine intense spicy notes supported by ripe plum, black fruit and violet aromas. This wine has a grippy acidity and well integrated tannins with well textured and rounded mouth feel.

Saronsberg Full Circle 368
Dark, ripe fruit flavours with floral notes and undertones of spice. A soft, full-bodied and elegant mouth feel is backed by integrated oak.

International Wines:

New Zealand

2010 Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc 370

Scented and summery, this Sauvignon Blanc has delicious vibrant aromatics that infuse the tropical fragrance of fresh passion fruit and juicy pineapples, with garden fresh basil and the spiciness of fresh tomato leaves.

2009 Cloudy Bay Pinot Noir 517

Intensely fragrant with alluring aromas of dark plums and lifted hints of blueberry, layered over spicy sandalwood and smoky bacon. The palate is succulent and flavoursome with dark fruits and toasty oak gently supported by plush tannins.

Argentina

2008 Flechas de los Andes Gran Malbec 210

Opaque purple coloured, it reveals a brooding bouquet of cedar, espresso, violets and black cherry. It borders on opulence, with layers of succulent fruit. A smooth textured wine, spicy flavours and a lengthy finish.

Germany

2007 Villa Huesgen Riesling 160

An elegant full-bodied Riesling with clear and complex minerality and fruit flavours reminiscent of crisp citrus fruit and hints of ripe apricots and peaches.

France:

Bordeaux

2004 Château Clarke 270

A dense, dark ruby coloured wine that has an expressive and intense nose of blackcurrant, cherry and plum aromas with hints of mocha, smoke and spice.

2007 Château des Laurets 300

This wine is dominated by aromas of fresh berry fruit with woody notes reminiscent of aniseed, cedar and vanilla. The palate is particularly smooth and round, a hallmark of great St. Emilion Merlot based wines.

2002 Château Angelus 1795
Big smoky fruit, intense, aromatic, spicy and complex.
Rich, dense, defined on the palate.

2001 Château Pichon Longueville, Comtesse de Lalande 2212
Very deep purple colour. Some extremely ripe fruit on the nose.
Dense but with attractive, mineral notes.

Burgundy

2006 Louis Latour Beaune, 1er Cru Domaine Latour 520
Wild berry aromas, with a light note of vanilla, and even liquorice due to its ageing in wood. Lengthy palate reflecting the preceding character.

2004 Louis Latour Meursault 550
This wine will dazzle you with elegant buttery notes, generous flavours of white fruit and a complex finish of citrus.

2006 Louis Latour Puligny Montrachet, La Garenne 1er Cru 817
One of Burgundy's finest whites. Concentrated and intense with aromas of exotic fruits with subtle acidity, allowing the smoothness and impressive finish to come through.

2005 Louis Jadot Gevrey Chambertin, Combe aux Moines 1er Cru 970
Louis Jadot produces a fine, elegant, full-bodied wine. It is structured and complex with a deep colour, developing distinguished aromas of blackcurrants.

Loire

- 2009 Ladoucette Sancerre Comte Lafond 340
Intense aromas reminiscent of white flowers, blackcurrants, mint and pepper.
The mineral notes of pebbles and flint, with nuances of lemon zest.

Rhône

- 2006 Domaine de Cabasse Gigondas 300
Intensive ruby red colour. Aromas of spices, white pepper, and candied fruits.
Beautifully round in the mouth. Spicy with fine mineral notes.
- 2009 Alain Graillot Crozes Hermitage 340
Classic Syrah aromas of spiced blackcurrant, cherry, violet and smoked meat. Focused
dark berry flavours and silky harmonious tannins. This could pass for a ripe new world
Pinot for its texture and sweetness.
- 2004 Château de Beaucastel, Châteauneuf du Pape 900
